

# **APPLICATION FOR GHANA SHIPPERS AUTHORITY UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR RMU FEMALE LEVEL 200 MARINE ENGINEERING STUDENTS**

## **1.0 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

The GSA Undergraduate Scholarship Scheme is a strictly merit-based academic scholarship scheme for female students of the Regional Maritime University who have completed the First Year of the Marine Engineering course.

An applicant must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a Ghanaian citizen.
2. Be a registered Full-Time undergraduate student at the RMU.
3. Be pursuing the B.Sc. Marine Engineering Course.
4. Be a Level 200 female student with a Grade Point Average (GPA) above 3.5.
5. Should not be a beneficiary of another scholarship scheme at the time of submitting the application.
6. Should be from a financially disadvantaged background.
7. Must demonstrate financial neediness through supporting verifiable document(s).

## **2.0 MODE OF APPLICATION**

1. An eligible student must submit her application Letter and copies of her supporting documents by **31<sup>st</sup> July, 2023 at 1600hrs Ghana time at the following places: Admission's office, office of the University Registrar or PDF all documents to [scholarship@rmu.edu.gh](mailto:scholarship@rmu.edu.gh)**
2. The applications shall be vetted by the RMU Scholarship Fund Committee to shortlist applicants based on the qualifying criteria outlined above.
3. Names with supporting documents and a brief written justification of three (3) recommended applicants shall be submitted to the GSA by the RMU Scholarship Fund Committee.
4. The GSA will select one (1) out of the three (3) recommended applicants for the award of the Scholarship.

### **3.0 SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS**

The documents listed below shall be submitted to support an application for the Scholarship. They are required to assist the Selection Panel to determine an applicant's ability or inability to fund their education:

1. Official Pay Slip or Payroll Record of the parents or guardians of an applicant; or the applicant if she is sponsoring herself through the Course.
2. The requisite qualifying certificates for admission to the Marine Engineering Course.
3. Recent school receipts/bills of siblings of school-going age (where applicable).
4. Tax Return receipts -VAT, Tabletop Hain king receipts, etc (if applicable)
5. Death Certificate or Burial permit (in the case where a parent / both parents are stated as deceased).
6. Pension Letter where a parent(s) / guardian(s) are stated as Retired.
7. Bank Statements of parent(s) / guardian(s).
8. National Health Insurance receipts (showing premium paid).
9. Evidence of other dependents of parents/guardians.
10. Any other supporting document(s) that will assist the Selection Panel in the determination and establishment of financial need
